



Elkin Creek Guest Ranch - Location and Directions

We are located on Elkin Creek at the south end of Vedan Lake. Approximately 2.5 hours by road, southwest of Williams Lake.

- Travel west from Williams Lake on Highway 20 to Hanceville (approx. 90 kilometers).
- You will travel down a big hill toward Lee's Corner (a very old looking store/gas station). Turn left on that road. It quickly turns to gravel.
- Further on you will cross the Chilko River and pass through Chilko Ranch (blue roofed barn).
- The road will fork. Take the main, which travels to the right and will lead you through Stone Indian Reserve.
- Continue on for approximately 75 km. It's a long, yet well maintained, gravel road. Be sure to keep your eyes peeled for some of the wild horses.
- You will also see an old run down hunting camp at New Meadow, about 43 kms. The km markers get sparse, but, at about the 60 km mark or so you will be on open road and, here, the mountain views are spectacular.
- The first switchback you will cross is Vedan Creek. You will come up on a hairpin corner, Semore Draw, and just down the road is a bridge that crosses the Taseko River. You will pass Big Lake on the right side.
- You will start to climb the Taseko Valley which leads right into the Elkin Valley. At the top of the hill is our cattle guard. Not long after, you should be able to see your destination, Elkin Creek Ranch, if you peek over the roadside and down to your right.
- Close to the bottom of the hill, and to your right, is our gateway.

Follow the driveway up to the main lodge and you will have finished the first leg of your adventure holiday.
